This Indenture made the second day  
of November in the year of our Lord one  
thousand eight hundred and sixty eight between  
Francis Davenport of Greenville County State aforesaid of the one part  
and Mrs Louisa C Bolling Executrix of L C Bolling deceased of the other  
part witnesseth Whereas Francis Davenport of the State aforesaid  
aforesaid has recently by obligation conditioned for the payment of Forty  
Bales of good Merchantable Cotton as further stated in said obligation  
bearing date the 2<sup>d</sup> day of November 1868 purchased of Mrs Louisa C Bolling  
Executrix as aforesaid a certain tract of land situate and lying in  
the State and county aforesaid known as the home place and conveyed by  
her late Billy Bolling decd. as sheweth by reference to deed of conveyance  
from heirs of said Billy Bolling to Shadrack C Bolling deceased on record  
in the Clerks office of Greenville County State aforesaid and whereas  
the said Francis Davenport desires further to secure the said Mrs Louisa  
C Bolling her heirs & assigns from any loss whatsoever against the said  
Francis Davenport his heirs and assigns. Now therefore this Inden-  
ture witnesseth that the said Francis Davenport of the State & County  
aforesaid for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and also  
in consideration of the sum of three Dollars to the said Francis Davenport  
by the said Mrs Louisa C Bolling in hand paid at and before the delivery  
and delivery of these presents have granted bargained sold and released and  
by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said Shadrack  
C Bolling Executrix of the late Shadrack C Bolling deceased as aforesaid  
all that tract and parcel of land situated and lying in Greenville County  
and State aforesaid known as the Home place and which it more partic-  
ularly described as follows beginning at Stake and running line S 5 W  
23 ch to Red oak thence S 6 E 59 ch to black oak thence S 60 W 50 5 ch to Hickory  
thence S 69 W 56 50 ch to Red oak thence N 10 W 48 50 to Hickory thence N 9 E 80

incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises  
before mentioned unto the said Mrs Louisa C Bolling Executrix as aforesaid  
her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and  
administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said  
premises unto the said Mrs Louisa C Bolling aforesaid and her heirs and  
assigns against me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
Provided always nevertheless that it is the true intent and meaning of  
the parties to these presents that if the said Francis Davenport  
his heirs executors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause  
to be paid unto the said Mrs Louisa C Bolling the sum of Forty Bales of  
good Merchantable cotton without claim or delay according to the  
provisions of the obligation above mentioned here and there
