Payne	Deed For Land	State of South Carolina Greenville County This indenture made this first day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty nine between J. J. Douthett judge of the County aforesaid and Alexander Payne of the same State and County. Whereas a petition was filed in the Court of Probate by James P. Moore administrator of the estate of Evelyn Coulier deceased to sell a certain tract of land hereinafter described of the estate of the said Evelyn Coulier deceased, to pay the purchase money of the said Land, and upon due consideration of the same, the judge of said Court did order the said land to be sold by the Sheriff of the County aforesaid for cash. When upon the Sheriff aforesaid did advertise the said land for sale on the first Monday in February in the year of above mentioned, and whereas the Sheriff aforesaid did on the said day expose to sale at public outcry on the terms aforesaid the said Land, when the said Alexander Payne was the last and highest bidder to whom the said Land was struck off for the sum of two hundred and sixty dollars. Now this indenture witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of two hundred and sixty dollars to me paid I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant
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bargain sell and release unto the said Alexander Payne and his heirs and  
 assigns forever all that tract of land situated in said County in the town of  
 Greenville adjoining lands of Thomas B Houston and others and containing seven  
 eighths of an acre more or less. Together with all the appurtenances thereto  
 belonging, and all the estate right title interest claim or demand which the  
 said Evelyn Coulier deceased, at the time of her death, had in or to the same  
 to have and to hold the said tract of Land together with all and singular  
 the premises improvements and appurtenances to the said Alexander Payne

Bee of the County and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and thirty seven dollars and fifty cents to me paid by Logan B. Cline of the same District and State have this day granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Logan B. Cline a certain lot or parcel of land situated lying and being in Greenville District within the corpora- tion limits of Greenville Village on the north West side of Coulterton Road immediately in rear and adjoining his other lot beginning at the corner of his latter or back corner of his front lot, on a crop about 20 ft wide, and runs thence with said Street 100 ft to a stake thence at 68 1/2 ft to the stake thence at 62 1/2 feet to the back corner of his other lot thence with his back line 128 1/2 ft to the beginning supposed to be 1/4 of an acre more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises together with their appurtenances unto the said Logan B. Cline his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend the aforesaid premises unto the said Logan B.
