This Indenture made this first day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty nine between J. S. Douthett Probate Judge of the County of Greenville and Robert S. Benson of the same State and County. Whereas a writ of summons to divide or sell a certain tract of land hereinafter described of the estate of William R. Green of said County deceased issued from the Court of Probate of said County and upon the return thereof the Judge of said Court did determine that the said Land could not be divided without injury to the parties interested and did order the same to be sold by the Sheriff of the County aforesaid on a credit of twelve months with interest from the day of sale. Whereas the Sheriff aforesaid advertised the said Land for sale on the first Monday in March in the year above written and whereas the Sheriff of the said County did on the said day expose to sale at public outcry on the credit aforesaid the said Land when the said Robert S. Benson was the last and highest bidder to whom the said Land was awarded off for the sum of two hundred and twenty five Dollars. Now this Indenture witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of two hundred and twenty five
