 the day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 eight hundred and sixty eight exhibited her Bill of Complaint  
 in the Circuit Court at Greenville Court House in the said  
 State against W. D. McDaniel et al. and the cause being at  
 issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at term  
 in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and  
 sixty nine when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature  
 deliberation in the premises did order adjudged and decree that
