and running N 60 W 10.00 to a spruce bush thence up McCayah Benoy fence row to the Branch of Cope's Bay poplar bottom Branch hewed up said branch with its meanders to the mouth of a Branch called Patrick River Spring Branch and turned on a maple thence up said Spring Branch to a Post-Corner in the fork of said Branch near a Spruce thence S 54 W 28 chs to a Post Oak corner 3' on Post-Bolney Land thence N 58 E 31.75 to Stake 3' in the Doubletree Bridge Road thence along said Road to a N 03' thence along the Road to a Rock & near a Peach tree thence a straight line to a Post Oak 3' thence S 56 E 13' to a Red oak 5' dead and down thence S 56 E 14.50 to a Post oak thence S 54 E 39.50 to the beginning on the River.
