Whitmore to say the sum of Three hundred and thirty Dollars damages and costs I have seized & taken of the lands and tenements of the said W. J. Whitmore all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing two and one fourth acres more or less situated and being in the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid near the upper bridge a cross Reddy River and bounded on the East by River street on the north by C. S. Brown lot on the west by lands of John Westfield and on the South by lands belonging to Estate of W. McRae Dead being the lot of land purchased from John Veckes C. S. Ferguson his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as the said W. J. Whitmore might have or ought to have had and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said Writ of Habeas Corpus aforesaid

Bennett and said Thomas M. P. Francis that and other Beginning at a P. O. three Runs S. 94° W. 70' to a Stone & three S. 33° E. 71° 50' to a Stone & three S. 16° W. 8° to a Stone & three S. 16° E. 9° to a Stone & three S. 20° E. 20° to a Stone & three Road line S. 71° 50' to a Stone in said Road S. & three S. 21° W. 10° 50' to a Stone & three S. 18° E. 16° 50' to a Stone & three S. 24° W. 16° to a Stone & three S. 68° W. 18° to a P.
