This Indenture made the eighth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand and eight hundred and seventy between Robert S. Burns of Greenville County South Carolina of the one part and G. W. Hudson of Greenville County South Carolina of the other part witnesseth Whereas the said Robert S. Burns is indebted to the said G. W. Hudson in the sum of four hundred dollars by date bearing now due with this Indenture and to be recovered for the payment of four hundred dollars with interest thereon from date at the rate of twelve percent per annum to be paid two years from last day this indenture witnesseth that the said Robert S. Burns of Greenville County of Carolina for and his Consideration of the premises aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of fifteen to be paid at the delivery of this Indenture to the said Robert S. Burns of Greenville County by the said G. W. Hudson of Greenville County as hereinafter at and before the delivery and delivery of these presents have granted a bargain and

released and by these Presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said G. W. Hudson all that piece of land and tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville County South Carolina near the Spartanburg Roads one and one half acres from Greenville Court house containing twenty acres more or less and having back lines Metres and bounds as shown by or plot of the same attached to a deed for thirty six acres more or less made to the said Robert S. Burns by G. W. Hammond and J. B. Blue Executors of his Estate of Dorcas J. Burns deceased said tract of thirty six acres by known or lot as sixteen of the lands of the Estate of said Dorcas J. Burns deceased as surveyed by William A. Henderson County Surveyor on the fifteenth day of October 1868. And the said tract of thirty acres which is bounded by this Indenture is the eastern portion of the tract of thirty six acres. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Dismenements and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to them and to have all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said G. W. Hudson of Greenville County South Carolina his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said G. W. Hudson of Greenville County South Carolina his Heirs and Assigns again me and my Heirs and against every person whatsoever lawfully claiming onto claims the same or any part thereof provided always nevertheless and notwithstanding the true intent and meaning of the parties to these Presents that if the said Robert S. Burns of Greenville County South Carolina his Heirs Executors or Administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said G. W. Hudson of Greenville County due the sum of four hundred dollars with interest thereon at the rate of twelve percent according to the tenor and effect of the note above mentioned there and forth these presents shall be utterly null and void any thing contained to the contrary thereof in any instrument whatsoever but it is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties to these Presents that unless default shall be made in payment of the aforesaid sum as before set forth and the intent for the same is that and may be lawful to sue for the said Robert S. Burns of Greenville County due the sum of four hundred dollars and quiet to hold and occupy possession and enjoy all and singular the premises above granted and released and every part thereof with the appurtenances and to have received and take the rents and profits thereof to his own particular use and behove anything herein contained to the contrary hereof in anywise notwithstanding the witness whereof the said parties have made at their hands and seals the day and year first above written sealed and delivered in the presence of J. D. Parkins
