Granted bargained sold and released and by these
presente do grant to him and release unto the said
Jacob L Hawkins all that lot tract or parcel of land
lying situated and being in the town of Greenville in
the District and State last above written beginning at a
Chesnut Stand on the line of the avenue leading from
the Augusta Road Street to the Furman University at 35. E 15th
feet to a stake 2^{1/2} S E of a Black Cock stump thence
S 82 2^{1/2} E 15th feet to a stake thence N 36. W 75th feet to a stake
on the bridge Avenue thence with said Avenue S 2^{1/2}
W 16th feet to the beginning being a portion of a lot or
tract of land conveyed to the said W. H. Peeler Brooks
by W. M. Peltier Andrew Miller James McQuir and the P.
M. Peeler together with all and singular the rights number
and dimentions to and appertaining to the said premises
belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenance to have
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Jacob L Hawkins his heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Adminis-
trators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Jacob L Hawkins
his heirs and assigns against myself and my
heirs and against every person whomsoever their
fully claiming or to claim the same or any part
thereof witness my hands and seal this twenty fourth
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and forty eight and in the ninth day of
the Independence of the United States of America.

Charleston County in the state aforesaid in the sum
of Two Thousand Six hundred and twenty four Dollars
with Conditions for the payment of Thirteen hundred and thirty
Dollars with lawful interest for the same to be paid at the dif-
ferent periods in saids Condition mentioned Now to know
all men that I the said Sam'l J. Doughty in considera-
tion of the said debt or sum of Thirteen hundred and thirty
Dollars for better security payment of the same note
in trust unto the said James W. Gray Special Ref'ree as afoin-
ded and to his Successors and Assigns according to the
Conditions of the said Bond. And this in consideration
of the further sum of one dollar like money to me the said
Sam'l J. Doughty by the said James W. Gray Spec Ref'ree
as aforesaid before the sealing and delivery of these these
to will and truly pay the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged have granted bargained sold remised released and
Confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell
remise release and Confirm unto the said James W.
Gray Spec Ref'ree as aforesaid and his Successors and
Assigns forever All that lot of Land with the buildings
thereon in Greenville County, State aforesaid situated at
out one mile from Greenville Court House South east
and parallel to the Pendleton Road beginning at Stake
at back of lot owned by Rev. S. S. Hallward own tract
Sixty(60) feet wide and runs thence along said street to
16 & four hundred(400) feet to a Stake at thence forth 14
W. six hundred(600) feet to a stake on a line on a tract
of Land belonging to the Estate of Mr. McRae deceased
thence up the line of said tract 16 W. four hundred(400)
feet to a street sixty(60) feet wide thence along said street
S 74 E six hundred(600) feet to the beginning said to contain
five(5) Acres to the said dimensions more or
