Ballentine	State of South Carolina Greenville County This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between John J Cooley of the State and County aforesaid Executor of the Estate of Jacob M Cooley deceased and George A Ballentine of the same State and Anderson County. Whereas a writ of summons to divide or sell a certain interest in a tract of land hereinafter described of the Estate of Jacob M Cooley Decd. Issued from the Court of Probate of said County and upon the return thereof of the Judge of the said Court did determine that the said land could not be divided without injury to the parties interested and did order the same to be sold by the executor aforesaid for cash. Whereupon the executor aforesaid did advertise the said land for sale on the twenty fifth day in January 1869 and whereas the executor aforesaid did on the said day aforesaid expose to sale at Public Auction for cash as aforesaid the said land when George A Ballentine was the last and highest bidder to whom the said land was struck off for the sum of One hundred and fifty one dollar.
