intervenor whences the said Martha A. Carson is indebted
to the said Martha McColl in the sum and just sum of
Two thousand Dollars and interest from this date by a sealed
note of which the following is a copy to wit
\$2,000.00 one day after date we the author of my promise to
pay Martha McColl or order the sum of Two thousand Dollars
with interest on the same at the rate of two per centum
per annum the said interest to be paid semiannually
for value received without hands and seals this thirteenth
day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and seventy

A. Carson for and in consideration of the sum of
one thousand dollars and also in consideration of the sum of Two thousand
to the said Martha A. Carson by the said Martha McColl
in hands paid at and for the sealing and delivering
of these presents have granted bargained sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said Martha McColl all that piece parcel and
tract of land containing eighteen hundred acres more or
less situated lying and being in the counties of Greenville
and Pickens in the state aforesaid on the waters of South
Saluda River being the tract of land formerly belonging
to Amos A. Carson deceased and bought by David McCall
of William M. Thomas commissioner in equity for Greenville
County the 10th instant and conveyed by the said David
McCall to the said Martha A. Carson by Deed recorded
in recorder's office conveyance office 1800 page 469.

at Greenville Court House and being the tract of land
on which the said Martha A. Carson now lies and more
particularly described in the deed of conveyance made by
William M. Thomas commissioner in Equity to David McCall
bearing date October fifth one thousand eight hundred and
sixty two also all that lot of land situated lying and being in
the city of Greenville County on Main street known as the
Hotel lot recorded by James P. Morris commissioner in Equity to
Martha A. Carson being the same lot now or lately occupied by
J. L. Southern and others and more particularly described
in the Plat attached to the return of the commissioners to
the court of Partition of the Estate of David McCall and describes
in said return as lot No 3 the hereinabove lot from James P. Morris
commissioner in Equity to the said Martha A. Carson being recorded
in the Register of Deeds conveyances office at Greenville Court House
in Books A & B pages 502 and 503 being with all and singular the
rights, members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining to
such and described above to hold all and singular the premises
before mentioned unto the said Martha McColl her heirs and
assigns forever and to her heirs my heirs executors and
administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Martha McColl her heirs and
assigns against me and my heirs and against every person
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
part thereof provided always interest and it is the true
intend and meaning of the parties to these presents that if the said
Martha A. Carson her Heirs Executors or administrators
shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said
Martha McColl the sum of Two thousand Dollars with interest
to the same according to the terms of the sealed note above men-
tioned thereto and for so much for these presents shall be
warranted held and released anything herein contained to the
contrary thereof in any way notwithstanding any it is con-
tingent and agreed by and between the parties to these presents
that until default shall be made in payment of the aforesaid
sum as before set forth and the intent for the same it
shall and may be lawful to take for the said Martha A. C.
Carson peacefully and quietly to have and occupy possess and
enjoy and singular the premises above granted and released
unto her and her heirs notwithstanding any provision
contrary thereto in any way made or standing in witness where-
of the said parties have hereunto set their hands and seals
the day and year above written
