

Counties of Greenville and Pickens and more particularly described in a Deed from Tardry McElvee to me Martha Carson recorded in Register of Deeds Office at Greenville Court House Book 16, Page 467 also above that Lot 6th land situated lying and being in the City of Greenville known as the Affidavit more particularly described in the return of the commissioners to the return of Partition of the Estate of Tardry McElvee, and described in said return as Lot No 6 To gether with all and sundry the rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to his said Premises belonging or in anyway incident or appertaining to have and to hold a lot and singular the said premises unto the said Martha McCall her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Martha McCall her heirs and assigns forever and against me my heirs executors administrators and assigns and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof provided always nevertheless and it is the intent and meaning of these parties to these presents that if the said Martha Carson do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Martha McCall the said West or sum of money aforesaid with the interest thereon according to the true intent and meaning of the said Bond or Obligation then this Deed of bargain and sale shall cease determine and be utterly null and void otherwise it shall remain in full force and virtue and it is agreed by and between the said parties that the said Martha A Carson is to hold and enjoy the said premises until default of payment shall be made the executors of McCall and the heirs of A Carson on first page made before execution witness my hand and seal this 2nd day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty and in the forty fourth year of the sovereignty and independence of the United States of America

And Ite aforesaid for and in consideration of the love Kindness and affection which I have for my son William D Sally and also in consideration of the sum of five dollars to me in hand paid by the said William D Sally the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William D Sally his heirs and assigns forever all that tract of Land wherein I now live situate lying and being in Greenville County on the North Fork of Saluda River containing Two hundred and five acres more or less and running as follows that is to say beginning on a water Willow oak on the said River thence N 57 E to a post oak thence N 20 Degrees E to a small pine a conditional corner made by John May and Edward Conch thence with the marked line to what was formerly Benjamin Conches line thence S 35 West with said line to a post oak thence West 19 chs to a Spanish oak thence N 40 W 24 chs to a persimmon on the river bank thence down the meandering of the said River to the beginning corner the same being a part of two tracts of Land granted to George Salmon together with all and singular the rights Members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said William D Sally his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above mentioned premises unto the said William D Sally his heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs Executors and Administrators and against all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
