

assembly of the State of South Carolina entitled an act to secure advances for agricultural purposes ratified the twentieth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six And it is further agreed by and between the parties aforesaid by their presents that the said Abraham Westfield for himself his executors administrators and assigns do hereby consent promise and agree to and with the said J. F. Donald as aforesaid that all the crops of whatever description raised and grown by him shall not be removed from his said farm or plantation without the written consent of the said J. F. Donald as aforesaid and that if the aforesaid amount of advances as aforesaid shall not well and truly be paid by or before the 15 day of October next it shall and may be lawful for the said J. F. Donald as aforesaid or the survivors of them if either of them should die before that date and at any time after the 15 day of Oct next peaceably and quietly to enter into any or all the messuages lands or tenements of the said Abraham Westfield and to take into their custody or the custody of the survivors of them if either should die and the same to hold and detain to their own use and behoof so that they may sell and dispose of said crops of whatever description at their pleasure returning the surplus if any should happen to be after paying off the abovesmentioned sum into themselves the said J. F. Donald as aforesaid into the said Abraham Westfield his executors administrators or assigns

Taylor his Executors administrators and assigns forever Provided nevertheless that if the said Frank Glymph his Executors &c the sum of sixty dollars with interest from date at ten per cent with all the costs that may accrue thereon this and as also a certain note bearing even date herewith given by the said Frank Glymph to the said W.
