This Indenture made the fourth day of July in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and seventy one between Wiley A.
 Bishop of the one part and William K. Eastley of the other
 part Witnesseth whereas the said Wiley A. Bishop is indebted
 to the said William K. Eastley in the sum of three hundred
 dollars as shown by a certain sealed note bearing date
 with this presents instrument and for the better securing
 of said amount of three hundred dollars Now this
 Indenture witnesseth that the said Wiley A. Bishop for and
 in consideration of the premises aforesaid and also in
 consideration of the sum of ten dollars to the said party of first
 part in one dollar by the said William K. Eastley in hand
 paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these
 presents have granted bargained sold and released and
 by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
 unto the said William K. Eastley All that tract of parcel
 of land containing seven hundred and four acres
 situate lying and being in said County on both
 sides of Mathis Creek water of South Saluda River
 bounded by lines running N 8 by J. S. Cargnum N 1/2 by Col
 Bay Hagood & land owned unknown S. W. by Land granted
 to Samuel Ogles & Cahill Beus on S. E. by vacant land
 being the same granted to Wm. Bishop & D. A. Anderson
 22nd day of December 1859 & surveyed on January 31st 1860
 by J. C. Hoyt D. S. and also a certain tract of land on
