Made the Eleventh day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy one between Ned Hill and Samuel Hill of the one part and Robert Thomason of the other part witnesseth that the said Robert Thomason has this day become bondman for the said Ned Hill and Samuel Hill in the sum of five hundred Dollars conditioned that the said Ned Hill and Samuel Hill shall keep the peace and be good behavours towards all the good people of Greenville County for the space of one year and one day and especially towards one Henry Cox Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Ned Hill and Samuel Hill for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars to the said Ned Hill and Samuel Hill by the said Robert Thomason in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Robert Thomason his heirs and assigns the following described personally property to wit one Black Mare Male one old cow four young fine Head of Hogs and also all my personally property of whatever description also one Samuel Haine and all my growing crop of cotton corn oats peas fodder and such like to have and to hold all and singular the personal property herein mentioned unto the said Robert Thomason his heirs and assigns forever And we do hereby bind our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend defend all and singular the said personally property unto the said Robert Thomason his heirs and assigns

against us and our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same on any part thereof Provided Always nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents that if the said Ned Hill and Samuel Hill shall well and truly comply with the conditions of said Bond according to the conditions of the Bond above mentioned then and from thenceforth these presents shall be utterly null and void accepting herein contained to the contrary thing in anywise notwithstanding And it is agreed and agreed upon by and between the parties to these presents that until default shall be made in the conditions of the aforesaid Bond as before let forth it shall not may be lawful to and for the said Ned Hill and Samuel Hill peacefully and quietly to hold use occupy possess and enjoy all and singular the personally property above granted and released and every part thereof anything herein contained to the contrary hereof in anywise notwithstanding In witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
