Farr of Greenville County in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and above and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James M. Farr all our right titles interest in a certain piece parcel or tract of land known as the Farr mill tract situate in Greenville & Pickens County containing two hundred and fifty acres more or less the first containing one hundred & thirty acres situate in Greenville County and State aforesaid the second tract containing one hundred and forty two acres situate in Pickens County and
