Know all men by these presents that I George Burrell of Greenville in the State of South Carolina in consideration of Three Hundred Dollars to him paid by Jacob Pruitt of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jacob Pruitt all that piece parcel or tract of land situated in the County and State aforesaid on branch waters of South Branch River it being the tract of land conveyed to me by Charles Russell for Beginning on a Rock Conditional Comm. on the Corn branch thence N 10 W to a Rock S 20 W 26 chs to R. O. 31 S 25 E 20 chs to a Spanish oak 31 thence S 30 W 32 chs to a R. O. 31 thence an off set of about 5' chain near a South East corner to a chestnut 31 thence S 72 E 15 chs to a Locust 31 A 80 E to the Branch thence down said Branch to a Black Gum a conditional Comm. thence Conditional line to a pine near Mountain Kico Church thence a Conditional line to the Beginning Rock Also a tract of land conveyed by Charles Russell to George Burrell Beginning on a State 31 thence a conditional line to a Marked chestnut thence to a Spanish O. thence to a marked white oak thence to the original line thence to the Beginning State containing one Hundred Sixty acres more or less Together with all and singular the rights Members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jacob Pruitt his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs &c. Executors & Administrators to warrant and firm defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jacob Pruitt his heirs assigns against myself and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

Executors and Administrators to warrant and firm defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Alexander Pruitt his heirs assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
