I to David This Indenture made the twenty
first day of November in the year one thousand eight
hundred and forty one between Martha E Whelden of the
first part and Jas A David of the second part both the parties
of the State and County aforesaid in witness whereof the said party
of the first part Martha E Whelden in Consideration of the
sum of one dollar to her paid her hold and by these presents
doe grant and convey to Jas A David of the second part all
that certain part in parcel of land known as the Bequette
Miles tract the two and forty acres of land which she had
privily sold to Cottell Jenkins being excepted containing about
two hundred and thirty acres more or less and bounded by land
of Peter Cunningham McHenry and Dorris the lines and
boundaries of the same being fully set forth in a deed
recd by Oliver Bonner to Flamingo Fullar with the
appurtenances and all the Estate title and interest of
the said Martha E Whelden therein. This grant is intended
as security for the payment of four hundred & seventy five Dollars
and fifty five Cents with interest of the sum from the first of
October eighteen hundred and forty one amount being one on
an note given by R Leman ~~his~~ ^{and} son Whelden of which
note the following is a correct Copy one day after date I
promise to pay to Jas A David or order from time to time
sum of one dollar and fifty five cents with interest from
the first day of October last at the rate of ten per cent
per annum for value received from 30th Nov 1871 R Leman Whelden
which payment if duly paid will render this Conveyance
void and if default shall be made in the payment of the
principal or interest above mentioned then the said party
of the second party and his executors or tenuys authorized
to sell the premises above granted or so much thereof as will
be necessary to satisfy the amount then due with the cost

N 24 W 47.5 to a Red oak 37.37 or more thence on the line Waller
and John P Waller line S 82 W 58 Ch to a small black log 3^{ft} on
said Creek thence down said Creek to Black Gum 35.5+ thence
S 88 E 4 Ch to Poplar 3^{ft} thence S 89 E 100 ft to white oak
on said Creek thence down said Creek to the beginning
