 in the State, for and above named Purchaser etc and
 released and by these presents do grant 13 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres well and
 release unto the said John T. Dillard all those tracts or
 parcels of Land Situate lying and being in Greenville
 County and State aforesaid on the South Side of the
 road leading Greenville to Spartanburg County known
 and on both sides of a branch of Edisto River being
 part of Lot No 2 of the Estate of Hugh Wailing Esq of Greenville
 County 61 $\frac{1}{4}$ Beginning at a point near the Greenville and
 Spartanburg road and running thence S 67 E 10.50 to a tree
 3r Thence N 50 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 17.27 to a stone 3r Thence N 36 $\frac{3}{4}$ W 18.50 to a
 stone 3r in the Greenville and Spartanburg road thence along
 said road to the Beginning Containing thereby Seven and
 one half acres more or less which is more represented by
 a plat of the same together with all and singular the rights
 number Residuam and appurtenance to the said
 premises before mentioned unto the said John T. Dillard his
 heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself and my
 heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and defend
