Ashmore of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by William H. Ashmore, Jr. of Greenville County in the State aforesaid. None granted Bargain Sale and release and by these presents do grant Bargain Sale and release unto the said William H. Ashmore for a certain piece of land or tract of Land containing Thirtysix acres in the same more or less situated in Greenville County in State aforesaid on Branches of Reedy River and on both sides of the Horse Shoal Road Beginning at Post gate 3^x 3^x on at big Gate house by Rock North 24.64 ch to stone 3^x 3^x on in place of a pine gone in old field thence N 81³/₄ W 22.56 ch to stone 3^x 3^x on in Horse Shoal Road thence N 87¹/₄ E 27.77 ch to stone 3^x 3^x on said Marion Creek Line thence along said Creek Line S 11 W 23.74 chs to Rock 3^x 3^x on in place Post gate gone in gnat thence S 66 E 6.96 ch to the Beginning Post east 3^x 3^x on dead together with all and singular the rights, members, incidentals & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have due to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William H. Ashmore for his heirs & assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant & defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William H.
