 said Louisa J. Gisham has conveyed and released to
 me all her right title and interest whatsoever and also
 any claim that she may have either directly or
 indirectly by Will inheritance construction or otherwise
 of in or to the stated property and effect of the late
 Samuel B. Hill deceased and of the late James B.
 Hill deceased and of her mother the late Letitia Hill
 deceased both in her own right and as guardian
 for her children (these two Deeds are made and
 executed and intended as a settlement found between
 me and the said Louisa J. Gisham as to everything
 between us pertaining to the estates above mentioned)
 Have granted bargained sold and released and by
 these presents do grant bargain sell and release
 unto the said Louisa J. Gisham during her
 natural life and at her death to be equally divided
 amongst her children, ^{any of which children being dead their children} to receive the share of their
 deceased parents all my right title and interest of
 in or to a certain piece or parcel of Land on which
 the said Louisa J. Gisham now lives located in the County
