 Powell his heirs and assigns forever the said tract

 same do have and to hold the said piece parcel
 and tract of land with its appurtenances unto
 the said Stephen Powell his heirs and assigns
 forever as fully and absolutely as I the said J. L.
 Southern might could or ought to grant bargain
