Together with all and singular the rights Members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining do have and Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James M. Thomason his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James M.
