Whereas under the United States Internal Revenue Law
a tax was issued against John Givens of the County of Craven
Third Collector District of the State of South Carolina by
Henry C. Hemmick Assessing Third District of South Carolina
and returned to Abram S. Wallace late collector of

on the list for August 1867 and that in pursuance of
orders from the said A. S. Wallace late collector as aforesaid
and in accordance with the Internal Revenue Law

of Distress Seizure issued by the said A. S. Wallace late

made in three months as prescribed by the Internal Revenue
Law of the United States the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
Eliza Gardner Bargained Sale and released unto the said John
H. Gardner and his wife Eliza all the Right Title Claim
and Interest which John Givens had either in Land or in
equity to see that Peter Parcell Hamptons, one Tract of Land
being and lying in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina
Third Collector District known as the Home Place
on the waters of North Saluda in Greenville County South Carolina
containing three hundred acres more or less adjoining Land
of Jacob Smith W. D. Rulifer G. H. Madge and others together
with all and singular the rights and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging or appertaining to the said premises and
all the right title property or interest persons or corporations
