right and claim of Dower of minor to all and singular the follow
premises to wit - All that piece parcel and tract of land containing
five hundred acres more or less adjoining lands of Mrs Frances
Davidson land formerly owned by Richard F Foster and often
situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on
South Saluda River being the same tract of land devised by
Robert S le Foster to his son John S Foster and subsequently
conveyed by said John S Foster to Richard F Foster and afterwards
reconveyed by said Richard F Foster to John S Foster
and afterwards purchased by W H Perry and H J Stroud at the
Marshalls sale under execution against said John S Foster.
