 bargain sell and release unto the said Martha  
 C. Cunningham the following described tract  
 of Land lying in the State and County aforesaid  
 about five Miles from the City of Gre-  
 enville viz. the Road leading to Spartanburg conti-  
 aining fifty Acres be the same more or less  
 and on the North side of said Road joining lands  
 of Abram Snice John Rains and James McCar-  
 ter on the following conditions to wit: To the
