78	Samuel Stradley To William Goldsmith	Deed	The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Samuel Stradley of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty one hundred Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by William Goldsmith of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Goldsmith an undivid- ed one half interest of in or to all that piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being within the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a point near the connecting line between the Atlanta and Richmond Air Line and the Greenville Columbia Rail Roads and running thence one hundred and fifty four feet with the front wall of J. Flanquetter's residence thence N 41° 00' 00" W one hundred and thirty eight feet six inches thence N 70° 00' 00" E one hundred and eight feet three inches to a stake on the right of way of the Air Line Rail Road connecting line and thence along said right of way to the beginning corner contain- ing one half acre more or less Together with all and sing- ular the rights, members, tenements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertain- ing.
