virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court

Eight hundred and Sixty nine at the suit of David
Anderson Executor to and directed commanding me that
I should deliver the sum of One hundred and forty two
Dollars damages and costs I have seized and part of the
lands and tenements of the said James Stone all that certain
piece parcel and tract of land containing Seventy five
Acres more or less situate and being in the County of
Greenville in the State aforesaid and known as the mill
place adjoining lands of George Tidman Hughes and
others and whereas the said premises with their appur-
tenances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the
said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned have been
exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased by James
Asher Stone of the County of Darlington in the State
of Georgia for the sum of Twenty four hundred and
fifty dollars being the highest sum that was bid for
therefor Now know ye that I A B Vickers Sheriff
aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid
did to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and
by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided
and for and in consideration of the said sum of Twenty
four hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid
or secured to be paid by the said James Asher Stone
the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknow-
ledge have granted bargained and sold and by these
presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said
James Asher Stone his heirs and assigns forever
the said piece parcel and tract of land
with its appurtenances and all the Estate
