To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said James Ashur Stone his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said A B Vickers might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the statute aforesaid and the said writ of Fieri Facias or otherwise.
