consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars to me in  
hand paid and before me the sealing of these presents by  
Hornell & Gauley in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and  
released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and  
release unto the said Hornell & Gauley all that tract and  
parcel of Land containing One Hundred and thirteen acres  
more or less situated lying and being in the State & County  
aforesaid on the waters of Laurel Creek Branch Waters of  
Rudey River Beginning in a River and running thence S 28 $\frac{1}{4}$  E  
31 chains and 20 links to a Rock on the side of 346 1 $\frac{3}{4}$  E 40 chains  
and fifty links to a pine 37 thence N 28 $\frac{1}{4}$  W 25 links to Rock 3  
thence on the Greenville Road to the Beginning corner bounded  
by lands of John P. Poor Tilmon Miller Thomas Howell &  
others. Being a part of the tract of land deeded by Elizah  
Pike to Martin D. Jones

Together with all and singular the rights members fixtures  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or pertaining,  
To have and to hold all and singular  
the said premises unto the before mentioned unto the said  
Hornell & Gauley their heirs and assigns forever, And I do  
hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to  
warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premi-  
ses unto the said Hornell & Gauley their heirs and assigns aga-  
inst me and my heirs or any person lawfully claiming or  
to claim the same or any part thereof,
