

be in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and
 six (1906) an annual rental of Six Thousand two hundred and
 fifty dollars (\$6,250) said rents to be paid semi-annually at
 the expiration of each six months. And the said party of
 the second part further covenants and agrees to and with the said
 parties of the first part to pay all State County and City taxes
 which shall or may accrue or be levied or assessed upon all the
 property herein granted and devised, during the term of
 this lease at a valuation of Twenty three thousand Dollars
 (\$23,000) into which valuation the value of the Factory and
 Picket rooms, lately erected by the parties of the first part
 at the upper Falls is not to enter, and further covenant and
 agree to pay all State City and County taxes, which shall or
 may accrue or be hereafter levied on all improvements they have
 already made or may hereafter, make during the term of this
 lease on that portion of the premises embraced within the
 purple lines, and marked No (3) letter (b) on plat hereto
 attached. It is further covenanted and agreed by and between
 the parties that at any time within three (3) months after the
 expiration of the term herein granted, the party of the second
 part shall and may have full power and authority to remove
 any or all of the machinery which they may have in said Mills
 or Factory Buildings. And it is further covenanted and agreed
 by and between the said parties, that the party of the
 second part may erect other buildings upon the premises
 and during the term of this lease pull down or change the
 same, as they may deem necessary or convenient. It is further
 covenanted and agreed, by and between the said parties, that
 all leases agreements and covenants by and between the parties
 of the first part and Messrs Sampson & Hall also are hereby
 declared to be null and void, and that this lease is substi-
 tuted in lieu thereof. This agreement executed in duplicate
 I, witness whereof the said parties of the
 first part have hereto affixed their hands and seals
 and the party of the second part have caused their
 corporate seal and the signature of their President to
 be affixed hereto the day and year aforesaid.
