Whereas by an order of the Court of Common Pleas bearing date the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August A.D. 1574, it was ordered that upon the payment of Seventy five Dollars by the administrators of John Westfield deceased to the firm of Cox, Birney & Co or to their trustees Whither Symmes and Thomas C. Gower the said trustees be authorized and required to convey to the heirs at law of the said John Westfield the triangular piece or parcel of land which the said firms agreed to sell to the said John Westfield and more particularly described hereinafter.

Now therefore know all men by these presents, That in pursuance of the aforesaid order and for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy five Dollars the receipt whereof we have by our knowledge and Whither Symmes and Thomas C. Gower as Trustees as aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto Emma M. Westfield, Mary Westfield and John O. Westfield heirs at law of John Westfield deceased all that certain piece and parcel of land situated lying and being in the city of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, containing three fourths of an acre more or less Beginning at a Stake 3<sup>y</sup> on the South side of Washington Street adjoining the Rail Road purchase thence S 4 E 98 ft to a Stake thence S 5 W 106 2 3 ft to a Stake corner of lands of John Westfield deceased thence S 50 E 72 1/2 ft to a Stake 3<sup>y</sup> thence along Cox Birney & Co's land N 40 E 21 1/2 ft to a Stake 3<sup>y</sup> in said Washington Street, thence N 50 W 24 7/8 ft to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights, members, appendants and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the saids Emma M. Westfield, Mary Westfield and John O. Westfield heirs at law of the said John Westfield deceased and their heirs and assigns forever. And we Whither Symmes and Thomas C. Gower as trustees aforesaid do hereby bind ourselves as trustees to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Emma M. Westfield, Mary Westfield and John O. Westfield heirs at law of the said John Westfield.
