The State of South Carolina
In all to whom these shall come;
I John L Southern Sheriff of

Greenville County and State aforesaid send greeting;
whereas by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias, issued out of the
Court of Common Pleas, held for the County of Greenville
testes the third day of November in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and seventy five at the suit of
Ferguson & Miller against F B McBee to me directed
commanding me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and
tenements of Frank B McBee to levy the sum of One
hundred thirty five and 4/100 Dollars damages and costs I
have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said
F B McBee all that certain piece parcel and tract of land
containing One Acre more or less situate and being in the
County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid being well lot
on Main Street in the City of Greenville and known
as the McBee Hall lot. And whereas the said premises
with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made
by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned
have been exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased
by W E McBee of the County of Greenville in the State
of South Carolina for the sum of Two thousand Dollars
being the highest sum that was bid there for.
