Jane Brown Known all men by these presents
that I Morgan Brown of
Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration
of the love and affection which I bear for my wife Jane
Brown of Greenville County and State aforesaid and also in
consideration of Twenty five Dollars to me paid by the said
Jane Brown have granted, bargained sold and released and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said:
Jane Brown all that certain piece of land situate
lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid
on Eunice River adjoining lands of Philip Bishop Benjamin
Drilling and others Beginning at a Stake or Bridge
on Eunice River and running thence with the road until to
a stone 3⁴ thence S 69¹/₂ W 18¹/₂ to a stone 3¹ and Post Oak
thence S 21 E 23.25 to a pine 13^x thence N 68 E 28.38 to a stone 3¹
thence, N 48 E 10.60 to a Stake on the bank of Eunice River
thence up the ditch on River to the bridge on the ditch the
beginning corner supposed to contain Forty five acres more
or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members,
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belong-
ing or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said Jane Brown her heirs and assigns forever
Provided that if my said wife Jane Brown should depart
this life and leave me surviving the tract of Land above
described is to revert back to me and my heirs and assigns
forever. And I do hereby bind my heirs executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Jane Brown her heirs
and assigns against myself and my heirs and every other
