 Deed: To all to whom these shall come
 I Perry D. Gilreath Sheriff of
 Greenville County, and State aforesaid send greeting: whereas
 by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias, issued out of the
 Court of Common Pleas held for the County of Greenville,
 tested the twenty fifth day of November in the year of our
 Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy five at the
 suit of William W. Bishop directed to John L. Southern
 Sheriff of Greenville County Commanding him, that
 of the goods and Chattels, lands and tenements of J. J.
 Westmoreland to levy the sum of Two hundred & thirty
 one ⁵/₁₀₀ for Dollars damages and costs, he seized and
 took of the lands and tenements of the said J. J. West-
 moreland, all his interest in all that certain piece parcel
 and tract of land, containing three hundred & twenty
 Acres more or less situate and being in the County of
 Greenville, in the State aforesaid adjoining lands of George
 B. Anderson John J. White S. K. White and others and where-
 as, the said interest in said premises with their appur-
 tenances since the seizure by him made by virtue of
 the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned has
 been exposed to sale at public vendue, and purchased
 by Jesse B. Westmoreland of the County of Greenville
 in the State of South Carolina for the sum of Five
 Dollars, that being the highest sum that was bid for
 therefor: and whereas said John L. Southern Sheriff went
 out of office without executing a title thereto, Now
 know ye, that I Perry D. Gilreath Sheriff aforesaid
 by virtue of said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid, and said
 sale and by virtue of the statute in such cases made and
 provided and for and in consideration of the sum of
 Five dollars to me in hand paid, or secured to be paid by the
 said Jesse B. Westmoreland, the receipt and payment
 whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargain-
 ed and sold and by these presents do grant bargain
 and sell unto the said Jesse B. Westmoreland her heirs
 and assigns forever, the said interest in said tract piece
 and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all the
 estate right, title and interests which the said J. J. West-
 moreland of right had of in and to the same, To have
 and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with
 its appurtenances, unto the said Jesse B. Westmoreland
 her heirs and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely
 as I the said Perry D. Gilreath might could or
 ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue
 of the statute aforesaid and the said writ of Fieri
 Facias or otherwise

In witness whereof I the said Perry D. Gilreath have
 hereunto set my hand and seal the eighteenth day of
 January in the year of our Lord one thousand
