

of the said decree, and in consideration of the sum of three dollars paid him by the said Peter Cauble the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said and his heirs and assigns all that tract of land situated in Greenville District in the State aforesaid adjoining lands of Taylor Williams and others on the east side of French River containing one hundred acres more or less beginning on a White Oak tree or near the bend of Lick Creek thence up the waters of said Creek to the fork thence up the South fork to a white Oak corner on the old line thence with the old line to a Chestnut corner thence to a pine corner adjoining Hender Robertsons old line thence with Robertsons line to a post Oak thence to the beginning corner (with the exception of a life estate sold by Wm A Cauble to Ed and E P Midville in a deed to a portion of 3 acres) Together with all and singular the hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging, or in anywise appertaining and the reversions and remainders rents issues and profits thereof; and also all the Estate right title interest Dower possession property benefit claim and demand whatsoever, both at law and Equity of the heirs and representatives of the said William A Cauble dead and of the parties to this sub and of all other persons rightfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof, by, from or under him, or either of them, to have and to hold the said land with its hereditaments privileges and appurtenances, unto the said Peter Cauble and his heirs and assigns to his and their only proper use benefit and behoof forever,
