Lawson, one of the Registers in Bankruptcy of said Court, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the fourteenth section of the act of Congress, entitled "an act to establish a uniform system of Bankruptcy throughout the United States" approved March 2, 1867 do hereby convey and assign to the said W. T. Shumate assignee as aforesaid, all the Estate, real and personal of the said Samuel Stradley Bankrupt aforesaid, including all the property of whatsoever kind, of which he was possessed or in which he was interested, or entitled to have, on the 12th day of March 1877 with all his deeds, books and papers relating thereto, excepting such property as is exempted from the operations of this assignment, by the provisions of the said fourteenth section of said act. Shumate his heirs forever, In trust nevertheless, for the use and purposes, with the powers and subject to the conditions and limitations set forth in said act.
