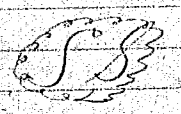

the sum of One thousand Dollars to us paid by Mrs E. C. Pickett of
the City of Greenville and County and State aforesaid have granted
bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said Mrs E. C. Pickett all that piece
parcel or lot of land situated lying and being in the City of Greenville
County and State aforesaid commencing at a stake on Washing-
ton Street corner of A. H. Deans lot thence above said Street
N 6 1/2 feet W six hundred and twenty five feet to corner of
J. B. Pickett lot thence S 29 3/4 W to two hundred and seventy and
one half feet to stake on Estate of John Whitfield deceased
thence S 6 1/2 E one hundred and twenty five feet to stake corner
of Deans lot thence N 23 1/2 E to two hundred and seventy and
one half feet to the beginning corner Together with all and
singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances
to said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
there and to hold unto the said Mrs E. C. Pickett her heirs and
assigns forever all and singular the premises before mentioned
