concern, & W. J. Shumate Assignee of A. L. Heeren of Greenville  
in said State, Bankrupt, send greeting! wherefore, the said  
A. L. Heeren was upon the day of AD 1876 adjudged  
a bankrupt, upon his petition, by the District Court of  
the United States, for the District of South Carolina. And whereas  
the rest and residue of his estate (embracing the lands hereinafter  
mentioned and conveyed) was by operation of law vested in  
me, the said W. J. Shumate his duly appointed Assignee.  
And whereas I the said W. J. Shumate Assignee as aforesaid  
in obedience to an order of sale to me directed by the  
District Court of the United States for the District of South  
Carolina, did upon the eighth day of January AD 1877 proceed  
to sell at public auction, the lands hereinafter mentioned and  
conveyed, being a part of the estate of the said A. L. Heeren  
Bankrupt, which lands were duly purchased by Perry D. Gilbreath  
he being the highest bidder, at the said sale.

Now therefore this indenture witnesseth, that I the said W. J. Shumate  
Assignee, as aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of twenty  
five hundred and eighteen Dollars to me in hand paid, the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and  
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto  
the said P. D. Gilbreath all and singular my right, title, interest  
and estate, of, in, and to all that certain piece, parcel and lot  
of land situate lying and being in the City of Greenville  
in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina  
on Buncome and Richardson Streets, bounded on the south by  
lot belonging to the Estate of R. Long Deceased on the West  
by lot of A. L. Heeren on the North by Buncome Street  
and on the East by Richardson Street, containing one  
half acres more or less, and known as the former  
Homestead of Mrs. Maria Thompson.

Together with all and singular the right, members, hereditam-  
ents and appurtenances whatsoever, to the said lot of land  
belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining thereto,  
reversions and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof,  
and also the Estate, right, title, interest, power, possession  
property, claims and demands whatsoever, both at law and  
in Equity, of the said A. L. Heeren and of all other per-  
sons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part  
thereof, so far as assignee I have the right to do.

To have and to hold the said premises with its hereditaments  
privileges and appurtenances unto the said P. D. Gilbreath  
his heirs and assigns and to his and their uses proper, use,  
benefit and behoof forever.
