dollars in hand paid by Robert Rosemond of said State
and County have granted bargained sold and by this presents
do grant bargain sell a piece parcel or tract of land situated
lying being in State and County aforesaid on branches of
Saluda River adjoining lands of the said Henrietta Shockley
James Payne and Nubik and Toobridge & to beginning
on a stone 3x three N 44 1/2 W 15 78 to stone 3x in the
Piedmont Factory Road thence Road line to the cross of
the Williamston Road thence the Williamston Road
line to a stone 3x three N 85 1/4 W 15 28 to a stone 3x
near the Golden Grove Chapel Church thence N 1/4 W
4 1/2 to a stone 3x three N 44 3/4 E 16 84 to the beginning
stone corner containing fifty four and one fourth
Acres be the same more or less Together with
all and singular the rights members hereditaments
appurtenances appertaining or in any wise incident
to the above described land I bind myself my heirs
executors admors and assigns to warrant and forever
defend all and singular of the above described
land unto Robert Rosemond his heirs and assigns
forever against myself my heirs executors admors
and assigns and against any person or persons
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof I also delegate the right to
change the road leading from the Williamston
Road to the Golden Grove Chapel to Robert Rosemond
his heirs and assigns
