being in the County and State of said on both sides of the
Golden Gate Road and waters of Reedy River, beginning at a
stake corner in said road and running thence S 67 1/2 W 47.00 ch
to a stone 8 x 8 on thence N 73 1/2 E 46.75 ch to a stone 8 x 8 on
old line, thence with said line S 51 1/4 W 2.68 ch to the beginning
