This indenture made the 9<sup>th</sup> day  
November in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and  
seventy seven between John Mason

and wife Helen of the County of Pines in the State of North  
Carolina of the one part and George Luther of the County of Gran-  
ville and State of North Carolina of the other part witnesseth  
that the said John Mason and wife for and in consideration of the  
sum of seventy five dollars to them in hand paid by the said  
George Luther the receipt whereof the said John Mason & wife  
Helen doth hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargained  
and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth give  
grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said George  
Luther his heirs and assigns forever one half of all that  
tract piece and parcel of land situated lying and being in the  
County of Greenville and State of South Carolina on the waters of  
Beaverdam Creek known as the Mason tract of land joining  
the Barton lands on the North the Ward lands on the South  
Col Gordon on the East the Watson lands on the West contain-  
ing one hundred and twenty five acres more or less and also  
all the woodways waters and water courses and all and every  
the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise apper-  
taining and the reversion and reversions remainder and remain-  
ders rents issues and the profits of the aforesaid lands  
and premises and every part thereof and all the estate right  
title interest claim property and demand whatsoever of the  
said John Mason & wife Helen of in and to the lands &  
premises hereby granted to have and hold with the appurten-  
ances unto the said George Luther in the proper use and  
behalf of the said George Luther his heirs and assigns forever  
and the said John Mason and wife Helen for their and their  
heirs the aforesaid lands and premises and every part thereof aga-  
inst them and their heirs and against the claim or claims of  
all and every other person or persons whatsoever to the said  
George Luther and his heirs and assigns shall and will  
forever warrant and defend by these presents and the said  
John Mason and wife have this day
