Know all men by these presents  
that J. C. Ross of Greenville County  
and State aforesaid for and in

consideration of Five hundred Dollars, to me in hand paid by J. R.  
Ross have granted, bargained and sold all that plantation or tract  
of land lying on Northside of Brushy Creek, waters of Enoree  
River, containing sixty five acres more or less Beginning at Rock  
ox on Richard Ross line, thence N 72° W 22 chains to stake ox  
on E. Koltzlaus line, thence S 4 3/4° E 19 chains to stake ox on  
Brushy Creek, thence down the meanders of Brushy Creek  
to mouth of Stillhouse Branch, thence up the meanders of  
Stillhouse Branch to Rock ox on R. Ross's line, thence N 76° W 15 chains  
to Beginning Rock, Together with all and singular the rights  
members and hereditaments and appurtenances of the said premises  
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to  
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
said J. R. Ross his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby  
bind myself my heirs and executors and administrators to  
warrant and forever defend all and singular the rights and  
premises before mentioned, unto the said J. R. Ross his  
heirs and assigns, against myself my heirs or any other person  
or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the  
same or any part thereof
