McDaniel, Clerk has, aforesaid, did convey the lands mentioned in the pleadings to the said trustees. Now, therefore, Known all men by these presents, that we Thomas de Lover and Whither Symmes, trustees aforesaid, by virtue of the power conferred upon us in and by the order and trust deed aforesaid, upon the written request of the parties aforesaid hereon endorsed, and in performance of our duty as such trustees and also in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and thirty one Dollars to us paid by W. B. Millwee before the delivery of these presents, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said W. B. Millwee all that piece, parcel or lot of land, being parcels of the lands above mentioned - situate and lying in the City ^{and} County of Greenville in the State aforesaid commencing at a Stake on the Rail Road purchase corner of Marshall & Mauldin's lot thence with Marshall & Mauldin's line N 85 1/2 E one hundred and twenty feet to a street thence along street N 4 1/2 W fifty feet to stake thence S 85 1/2 W one hundred and twenty feet to said lot purchase thence S 4 1/2 E fifty feet to the beginning corner known in Dickson's Plat as lot No 2 ^{also} one other lot in the same city and State commencing on West Street corner of lot purchased by Whither Symmes running with his line S 55 1/2 W one hundred and eight feet eight inches to a stake thence S 4 1/2 E two hundred and eighty four feet and three inches to a stake on street thence with said street N 85 1/2 E one hundred and thirty five feet and six inches to stake thence N 55 1/2 E with street one hundred and thirty feet and seven inches to West Street stake thence along West Street N 34 1/2 E three hundred and twelve feet to the beginning corner known in Dickson's plot as lot No 12 containing one acre, one Rod and twenty six perches more or less, ^{also} that lot or parcel in the same city and state commencing at corner of forty feet street running with said street N 85 E one hundred and fifty feet to stake on street thence with street N 4 1/2 W one hundred feet to stake thence S 85 1/2 W one hundred and fifty feet to street thence with street S 4 1/2 E one hundred feet to the beginning corner known in Dickson's plot as lot No 16 ^{also} that lot in the same city and state commencing at stake on forty feet street running with street S 55 1/2 W eighty five feet and five inches to stake on street thence S 4 1/2 E one hundred and nineteen feet and ten inches to stake thence N 85 1/2 E one hundred and sixty six feet and two inches to stake thence N 34 1/2 E one hundred and eighty four feet and eight inches to beginning and known in Dickson's plot as lot No 28 Together with all and singular the rights.
