This indenture made the second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight between William A. M'Daniel Esquire, Clerk of the Honourable Circuit Court for Greenville County, at Greenville Court House in the said State, of the one part and Jno M. Crotwell of the other part; Whereas the said Clerk on about the 25th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven did exhibit his Bill of Complaint in the Circuit Court, at Greenville Court House in the said State against James Bamister for the foreclosure of a mortgage, and the cause being at issue before the Honourable Court, came on to be heard at July term, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight when the said Court, after full hearing thereof, and mature deliberation in the premises, did order adjudge and decree, that the tract of land described in the Complaint should be sold at public auction, by the Clerk of said Court, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their decree or order, as by reference thereto in the Registry of the said Court will appear, And the said William A. M'Daniel Esquire as Clerk of the said Court after having duly advertised the said land for twenty one days for sale, by public outcry, on the second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight did then openly and publicly, and according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the said land above described, unto the said Jno M. Crotwell for twenty three hundred dollars he being, at that price, the highest bidder for the same. Now therefore this indenture witnesseth, that the said William A. M'Daniel Esquire, as Clerk of the said Court, wherein and by virtue of the said decree, and in consideration of the sum of Twenty three hundred Dollars paid him by the said Jno M. Crotwell the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jno M. Crotwell his heirs and assigns all that piece parcel and tract of land situate lying & being in Greenville County State South Carolina on both sides of Ecorse River and including Saw & Grish mills on said land & having the following metes & bounds beginning at the bridge on Ecorse River known as Combs bridge running thence North thirty yards to an oak tree near two persimmon trees thence East to a dead walnut tree on top of the ridge near Combs corner thence with boundaries line to Combs old line North East thence Combs old line to and end to Jeremiah & Samuel Foster to a Post east being corner of Combs Foster line on Rutherford road thence South West with old Rutherford

road to a Post Oak corner near old mill road being Combs & Duckett's corner thence west with George Duckett's line to Ecorse river thence across Ecorse river with Geo. Duckett's line to a corner of Geo. Duckett's on south side of river thence South East to a persimmon tree marked with a cross on Rutherford road thence East with Rutherford road to the beginning corner containing five hundred acres more or less being part of the land deeded to Peter Combs by Martin Ayres & others, & conveyed to Henry A. Combs together with all the water privileges conveyed to Ruben Ayres by Aron Kemp by deed bearing date 13th Decr 1834 together with all and singular the hereditaments rights, numbers and appurtenances whatsoever, to the said tract of land belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversions and remainders rents, issues, and profits thereof, and also all the Estate right title interest, power, possession, property, benefit, claim and demand whatsoever, both at law and in equity, of the heirs and representatives of the said Jas. Bamister and of the parties to this suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof, by, from, or under them, or either of them, to have and to hold the said tract of land with its hereditaments, privileges and appurtenances, unto the said Jno M. Crotwell his heirs and assigns, to his and their only proper uses, benefit, and behoof forever.
