of the sum of two hundred and seventy four and 40/100 Dollars to me in hand paid all and before the sealing of these presents, by William Verdin in the state aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Verdin all that plantation or tract of land lying on the North side of Colder Creek, waters of Coover River containing forty three and a half acres (more or less). Beginning at stake x on James F Watson's line on Colder Creek, thence N 2° E 25.50 chs to rock x on State Road, thence N 16 1/2° W 8.69 chs to Rock x thence N 27 1/2° W 5.50 chs to Chestnut stump thence N 4 W 5.50 chs to rock x thence N 54 W 1.62 chs to Rock x thence S 26° W 19.25 chs to Hickory x thence S 3 1/2 W 11.70 chs to Maple x thence down the meanders of Colder Creek to beginning stake x. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said William Verdin his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Verdin his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, or any other person or persons lawfully claiming to claim the same or any part thereof.
