(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold
and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said Hamlin Beattie all of that tract or parcel of land in
said County and State lying on the Marietta Road some nine to ten
miles from the City of Greenville containing two hundred and
fourteen acres more or less being the tract of land which was
bid off by me at Sheriffs sale on behalf of Hamlin Beattie
Administrator and the Executor of D M B Earle deceased when sold as
this property of Cols Montgomery and the same which was the subject
of the action entitled Laramie Lehnhardt against myself & others in the
Court of Common Pleas for Greenville County. Together with all
and singular the rights & members hereditaments and appurtenances to
the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining
to have and to hold all and singular the said premises before
mentioned unto the said Hamlin Beattie and his heirs and assigns
forever. And I do hereby bind myself heirs executors and ad-
ministrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the
said premises unto the said Hamlin Beattie heirs and assigns
against me and my heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the
same or any part thereof.
