

Embraced in the pleadings in said cause, and upon the report of said Special referee coming in, containing the various recommendations therein more fully set forth, it was on the 17th day of August AD 1874 among other things, ordered that Whittier Symmes and Thomas L. Gowers, be appointed trustees, to whom William A. McDaniel Clerk of the said Court, should convey the said lands, to have and to hold the same to, for and upon the purpose, uses and trusts, as set forth and declared in the deeds reported by the said referee; and whereas, the said William A. McDaniel, Clerk as aforesaid, did convey the lands mentioned in the pleadings to the said trustees. Now therefore I know all men by these presents, that we, Thomas L. Gowers and Whittier Symmes, trustees as aforesaid, by virtue of the power conferred upon us, in and by the order and trust deed aforesaid, upon the written request of the cestuis que trust and in performance of our duty as such trustees, and also in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Twenty Dollars, to us paid by Helen J. Shumate before the delivery of these presents, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents, do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Helen J. Shumate, all that piece, parcel or lot of land, being parcels of the lands above mentioned situated and lying in the City of Greenville, near the Air Line Railroad's depot in the County and State aforesaid commencing at the corner of my garden and a fifty foot street and running North 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ W along said street 100 feet to a stake & thence North 85 $\frac{1}{2}$ East 150 ft to a stake on back street, thence South 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ East 100 feet along said street to a stake & thence South 85 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 150 ft along my garden fence to the beginning point. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Helen J. Shumate, her heirs and assigns forever freed from all discharged of all further trusts whatever, and we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said Helen J. Shumate, her heirs and assigns against us, and our heirs and every other person, whomever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof, by, through and under us, as trustees aforesaid.
