that I Ho. C. Cannon in the

State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred and
sixty nine Dollars good and lawful money of the United States
of America to me paid by John Wheeler of the County of Spart-
anburg in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and
released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
the said John Wheeler all that certain tract portion or parcel of
land situated being and lying in the County of Greenville in the
State aforesaid on the South West side of South Tyger river
being known as the Jesse Cannon tract and willed to Ho. C.
Cannon by said Jesse Cannon bounded on the West by Jesse
Cannon (junior) land and Eliza Callenger's land on the North
by lands of Green Rector and South Tyger River on the East by
land of Benjamin Burnett and on the South by lands of said
Benjamin Burnett containing certain land that was willed to Ho. C.
Cannon by his father Jesse Cannon with the exception of
that portion of said land which was cut off to Jesse Cannon as
shown by a plat made by J. K. Decker surveyor for Jesse W.
Cannon February 6th 1867 containing eighty seven acres more
or less. Together with all and singular the rights members
hered tenements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John
