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apforesaid, and greeting: whereas by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the County of Greenville, on the twenty ninth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy six at the suit of G F Torres to me directed, commanding me that of the goods and chattels lands and tenements of Thomas L Stokes to levy the sum of Fifty Dollars damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Thomas L Stokes all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing three hundred and thirty acres more or less situate and being in the County of

Greenville, in the State aforesaid, adjoining lands of Joseph Dumeau Mrs Manuwa Bradley and others, and whereas the said premises, with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue; and purchased by D P Stokes of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina for the sum Four hundred and sixty Dollars that being the highest sum that was bid for the same. Now know ye that I Perry D Gilreath, Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid, to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided, and for and in consideration of the said sum of Four hundred and sixty Dollars to me in hand paid, or secured to be paid, by the said D P Stokes the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said D P Stokes his heirs and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all the estate, right title and interest which the said Thomas L Stokes of right had, of in and to the same, To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land, with its appurtenances, unto the said D P Stokes his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as if the said Perry D Gilreath might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid, and the said writ of Fieri Facias, or otherwise.
