Gower and Whittier Symmes, trustees as aforesaid, by virtue of the power conferred upon us, and by the order and trust deed aforesaid and in performance of our duty as such trustees and also in consideration of the sum of One hundred seventy three $\frac{1}{2}$ dollars to us paid by Helen J. Shumate before the delivery of these presents, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents, do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Helen J. Shumate, all that piece parcel or lot of land - being parcels of the lands above mentioned - situate and lying in the City of Greenville County & State aforesaid commencing at a stake or on Air Line RR purchase and forty ft street, running thence N. $\frac{1}{2}$ W ten feet to W J. Shumate's corner, thence with the said W. J.
